CLINICAL FINDINGS

Mr. Stewart was tested using ImPACT on 01/22/12 to evaluate his cognitive functioning and the results were compared to prior results. All cognitive indices now measured as consistent with baseline levels of performance. Subjectively, he denied all symptoms.

RECOMMENDATIONS

As of 01/22/12 Mr. Stewart no longer displayed any identifiable neurocognitive declines or reported any subjective symptoms associated with the effects of his recent concussion. He appears to have made a good and full recovery at this time. Overall, there are no neuropsychological restrictions to allowing him to participate in the Return to Play process. Repeat evaluation with ImPACT is not necessary unless there is a significant decline in his clinical symptom presentation.
